WHAT JULIE BEREN PLATT TEEN INNOVATION GRANT (TIG) CAN OFFER

FUNDS This program offers up to \$1,000 to empower you to play an active role in turning your idea into reality.

MENTORSHIP You will be paired with a mentor who acts as a thought partner and can offer guidance as you work towards new goals. You will meet with your mentor once a month.

- Embody Jewish values (e.g., caring for those in need).
- Would benefit from the wisdom of a mentor.
- Need help launching with additional funding and support.
- Will begin to flourish within our six-month program timeline.
- Would benefit from the support and inspiration of a group of teen innovators.

TEEN INNOVATION GRANT DOES NOT FUND...

- The development of and/or launching of phone apps.
- Transportation (e.g., gas mileage, ride sharing, flights, etc).
- Requests for personal use items.
- Donations to other 501(c)3 organizations.

EXPECTATIONS OF PARTICIPATING TEENS:

PROJECT-RELATED EXPENSES

YOU WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR MANAGING PROJECT-RELATED EXPENSES.

- You will need to collect and save receipts for all project-related expenses.
- You will be responsible for creating and submitting monthly expense reports.

WHAT ARE EXAMPLES OF PROJECT-RELATED EXPENSES?

Website design, supplies & materials, training, etc.

MENTORSHIP

YOU WILL BE MATCHED WITH AN ADULT IN THE COMMUNITY WHO WILL BE YOUR MENTOR.

- Your mentor is your thought partner. This person can offer advice and guidance as you develop your project.
- You and your mentor will have one scheduled meeting per month. (Virtually or in person)
- It is your responsibility to keep in touch with your mentor, ask for help, and set time aside for meeting.

PARTICIPATION

YOU ARE REQUIRED TO ATTEND...

- Orientation.
- Workshops / Meetings.
- Final Showcase where you will present your project.

AM I ELIGIBLE?

QUALIFICATIONS FOR TEEN INNOVATION GRANT

- Currently be in 9th-12th grade.
- Live in the Greater Los Angeles area.
- The lead teen of each project must identify as Jewish.
- Submit a fully completed application by September 16, 2024.
